

Report on the 2012 International Mathematical Olympiad held in Argentina noted that Lim Jeck, a 17-year-old of NUS High School, was ranked first out of 548 contestants, and was the only contestant with a perfect score at the Olympiad. Singapore was ranked seventh at the contest with one Gold medal, three Silver medals and two Bronze medals. Report noted that, Singapore's best showing was in 2011 when the team, including Lim Jeck, was placed third overall.

Report noted comments from Lim Jeck's father who said that there was no training provided to his son and none of his children had tuition. He also praised NUS High for helping his son build a very strong maths foundation.
